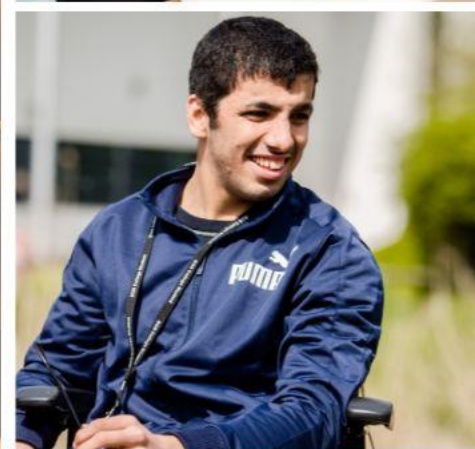


Overview of College:

- 4000 16-18s
- 1500 apprentices
- 5000 adult learners
- 500 higher education learners
- 200 pre-16s
- 400 high needs learners
- 6 main campus: Filton, WISE, Horizon, Queens Road, Stroud, Berkeley

Stroud Campus:

- 760 full-time 16-18 learners (capacity for 1200)
- Growing number of 14-16s – mainly GCSE Plus (supporting Elected Home Educated community)
- No A levels
- 250 apprentices – Construction, Financial & Professional Services, IT/Digital
- 150 high needs learners – Foundation Studies
- 1000 adult learners – Art, ESOL, Maths/English, Well-being, Counselling
- Curriculum focus: Broad vocational (Construction, Hair & Beauty, Health, Business, Digital Media/Games/Music, Art & Design Animal Science, Forensic Science, SEND)
- Home of Growth Hub – supporting 100s of local businesses





Berkeley Campus:

- Home of UTC – 14-18 Engineering and Cyber/Digital – 300 students
- Development of the SGS Low Carbon Training Centre – supported by SDF ad SEDF; will open in September 2023 focussed on ‘solar photovoltaic, solar thermal, air source and ground source heat pumps and retrofit insulation and air-tightness’

Growth areas and opportunities at Stroud:

- Rebranded campus to focus on 'Creativity, Sustainability & Well-being' – in line with areas of growth
- SGS Create – dedicated 14-16 centre for young people for whom mainstream education is not right; GCSES plus a creative curriculum. Additional support for those with SEMH. 80 starts September 2023
- Further investment in Science – GCSE Science, plus recently launched Forensics, Animal Science plus launch of T levels.
- Launch of T levels from 2024 – Health and Social Care, Animal Science, Design and Technology
- Development of a Centre of Excellence for Counselling
- Launch of Level 3 Sustainable Futures programme
- Retraction from HE (Focussed elsewhere at WISE/QR); Stroud focussed on Entry – Level 3
