






Referrals since 21st September 2021 – 31st October 2022 = 391











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




What our support looks like

Informal support through the Careers Cafe

Contacting employers on customers behalf to discuss opportunities, reasonable adjustments

Hub Broker 1:1 support with seeking employment Vocational profiling, action plan, Kudos AD Retention: Continual support even after employment has been found to ensure sustainability

Each referral is triaged by the Hub Brokers and a pathway destination is identified

Supporting referrals to identify their training needs and skill gaps

Signposting to organisations i.e. training and skill providers, debt advice etc

Complimentary use of Hub computers for customers to complete job applications or video interviews in a quiet space

Challenges

- Instability of the economy
 - Need to be able to respond in times of full employment,
 high unemployment or increases of economic inactivity
- Recruitment into posts within the Hub
- Capacity to cover the whole County
- Preconceptions and myths
 - Of employers about people with barriers to employment
 - Of individuals about employers or the benefits system
- Employers
 - Multiple requests for opportunities from employment and skills providers
 - Lack of knowledge about the support available to them
- Sustainability most Hub funding streams are temporary

- Run from 1 December 2022 to 31st March 2024 (pre-UKSPF)
